Issue:

How to get a file while you are away from your host.

SSH is a secured telnet, to connect to a linux host running ssh service type:

Ssh -l "user_name" "host_name"

It is possible to copy files through the tunnel.

Scp [user_name@host_name:/etc/samba/smb.conf](#) / *target_path_on_local*

```
scp root@192.168.1.111:/etc/samba/smb.conf
```
