## ISSUE: mount usb key

Concerned platforms:

OS : Linux Fedora Core2 Kernel 2.6.x

Vernouillet, 02.02.05

### Symptoms:

USB key is not mounting up

Action:

Try to call “**usbview**”  
You can mount it manually.

To see if USB device is recognized you can check **dmesg**  
At the end you will see entries concerning the USB device and how it is mounted.  
USB is emulated as an SCSI device so if your system has no SCSI the USB device will pop out as “sda1”.

Create a directory :

```
# root@stargate:/home  
> mkdir /home/usb  
> mount /dev/sda1 /home/usb
```
