Issue:

Executing a ltime consuming process in remote and willing to shutdown your work station.

Sollution: **nohup**

examples:

This wget command will download arround 3GB of datas, in this case if you close your telnet or Vnc session download will be stopped.

```
# root@panoramix:/root
> wget 'ftp://interlab-net.com/dvd_source.iso'
```

This wget command enriched with “**nohup**” ahead and terminated with “**&**” will allow you to close your telnet or Vnc session and download will continue.

```
# root@panoramix:/root
> nohup wget 'ftp://interlab-net.com/dvd_source.iso' &
```

Following this there is not echo of performed action. To verify that process is going on type: This wget command

```
# root@panoramix:/root
> cat nohup.out
```

You should see some thing like :

```
# root@panoramix:/root
> cat nohup.out
149900K ..... -9% 127.55 KB/s
149950K ..... -9% 124.38 KB/s
150000K ..... -9% 127.23 KB/s
150050K ..... -9% 124.38 KB/s
```
