### Issue:

All wifi and eth prefs are stored, when you are migrating or those Wifi prefs are lost; passwords, user names, wifi names...

Here is the procedure in command line

Data are stored in:

```
/home/account_name/.gconf/system/networking/connections
```

So just move/copy it over the account you wish:

```
cp /home/account_name/.gconf/system/networking/connections  
/home/new_account_name/.gconf/system/networking/connections
```

in one line, of course you need rights to write in both accounts.
