Working with Shared Projects

Creating a Userlist

The first step once the project space has been allocated is to create a user list. (This is a list of the computer names of the machines that are connecting to the shared environment) The userlist needs to be created in the Project Space folder and be saved as a .dat file, ie, userlist.dat (this can be created using Notepad)

It is recommended to rename each computer to that of the user ie, instead of HP-Laptop change it to the users first name. Should you not wish to change the machine names, simply write the machine names as they stand in the userlist file.

To change the machine name in Windows:

- Right click My Computer
- Click Properties
- Click Advanced system settings
- Click the Computer Name tab
- Click the Change button
- Change the Computer name to that of the user
- Click OK and reboot

Once the machines have been renamed, add each user/machine name to the userlist.dat file on its own line and save the file.

Example:

Changing Edit Ownership

When a user creates a new edit/sequence they have ownership of the edit/sequence, meaning they have read/write access to it. Other users in the same project will then only have read access, ie, they cannot make changes to the edit/sequence but they can open it, play it or make a copy of it. Once a copy has been made of an edit/sequence the user that created the copy then has read/write access to this; as they created it. Any changes made to an edit/sequence will be updated in all rooms of the project.

Creators/owners of edits/sequences can give permission to other users. To do this:

- Click the padlock icon that appears on the right hand side of edit viewers (the padlock icon will only appear when the project browser is set to a network project space)
- On the menu panel that opens, click the dropdown arrow and select a new user name to transfer ownership to (this will automatically take the edit out of Rec mode)
